THE MAIN OBJECTIVE of KIDS' aquatic program is to make each student "water-safe". Students will develop a respect for the water and learn to enjoy it to its fullest. Our pool is 18 x 36 ft. and 16 in. to 4 ft. deep with an average water temperature of 90°. It is not designed for diving or advanced stroking skills. We have dressing rooms, restrooms and showers. Parents view classes from the comfort of our air-conditioned lobby.

TINY TOOTS (3-36 Months - Parent Participation Required): Mom and/or Dad will help the child to develop coordination, strength and physical skills, as well as water safety skills, through the direction of a *KiDS* swim instructor. A swim diaper is required for our "Tiny Toots" and a towel. We do have swim diapers for sale at *KiDS body shop*. PLEASE, NO REGULAR DISPOSABLE DIAPERS.

*** ANY CHILD UNDER 3 YRS. MUST RECEIVE INSTRUCTOR RECOMMENDATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:**

SUBMARINES: Our objective is to help develop a respect for the water as well as to develop strength, coordination, self-confidence and the ability to participate in a group setting. Submarines work on Level 1 skills. Our instructors will show them how to propel themselves to the side of the pool and hold on until someone helps them out. They will also work with kick boards and retrieve objects from under the water. Student/teacher ratio is 4/1.

MOTORBOATS: The Motor Boats will work on Level 2 skills, as well as water safety. In each Motor Boat session we will introduce rhythmic breathing, floating, stroking and the use of life jackets. Student/teacher ratio is 4/1.

SKIPPERS: Skippers have successfully passed Levels 1 and 2. They enthusiastically work on the crawl stroke with rhythmic breathing, the back crawl, treading water and the butterfly kick. Skippers also work on safety skills and will view a safety video.

CLIPPERS: Clippers is our most advanced water safety class for students who have passed Levels 1, 2 & 3. Students refine their freestyle stroke with rhythmic breathing, attempt a fully coordinated butterfly and are introduced to the side, breast and elementary back strokes. They also continue to work on safety skills. As appropriate, students will be tested for certification at Level 4. Student/teacher ratio is 4/1.

TO REGISTER FOR CLASS . . . Enrollment begins February 12, 2018. Our preferred method of enrollment is online, and our preferred method of payment is credit/debit card through our online Parent Portal (www.kidsbodyshop.com/parent-portal). If you are unable to register online, complete the registration below and mail (check) or drop off with payment (cash, check, or card) and Release of Liability form. If your class choice is full, we will call or email you with an alternate choice. **Registrations submitted before February 12, 2017 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Registrations are on a first-come-first-served basis, and will not be accepted without payment. Registration will end 2 weeks after each session's start date.

Rules, Terms, Conditions, and Policies

REGISTRATION FEE:

All Students will be charged a registration fee of \$30/student per year.

PAYMENT PROCEDURE:

Gymnastics fees are payable on a monthly basis and are due by the end of the month for the upcoming month. We do offer an "early bird" \$2 discount per student if these fees are paid or postmarked by the 24th of the current month for the upcoming month. Gymnastics class fees paid on the 1st of the month or later will be charged an additional \$5 per family. Checks are to be made payable to KiDS. There will be a \$15 charge for any returned checks.

Swimming fees are payable upon sign up. Our preferred method of payment for swim classes is by credit/debit card through Parent Portal. We also accept cash and check.

CREDIT CARDS (For Swim Student Fees Only):

We currently accept credit/debit card payments through Parent Portal only.

If any credit/debit card information is stored in your Parent Portal account, the card will be automatically drafted on the 24th of the month if there is a balance due.

FAMILY DISCOUNT:

If more than one family member is involved in the same program (gymnastics or swimming) at KiDS and/or Omega, your account qualifies for a discount on the total class fee due per month. Discounts apply only to full months of tuition. A second child (or more) receives a \$5 discount (per additional child). As gymnastics and swimming are separate programs, family discounts do not apply when you have one child in swimming and one in gymnastics.

DROP PROCEDURE:

PARENTS MUST NOTIFY THE OFFICE TO DROP A STUDENT FROM CLASS. This must be done before the 1st of the month to avoid being billed.

Please note: You are responsible for payment for your student's classes WHETHER OR NOT YOUR STUDENT ATTENDS CLASS until the time you notify the office. Please do not rely on your student to verbally let us know that he/she will no longer be attending classes. If a student stops coming to class without notification then that student's account will be charged. This charge will be for holding the student's place in that class instead of offering that place to one of the many on our waiting list.

REFUNDS:

Credits will only be given for illnesses or injuries of 3 weeks or longer. A doctor's not must be presented. Pro-rated fees are based on a four-week month. There is a \$5 per student processing fee for any refunds prior to a class starting, but no refunds will be given once classes for the month/session have started. **Registration fees are non-refundable.**

MAKE-UP POLICY:

Make-up classes are offered as a courtesy to our customers. However, you must notify the office at least **2 hours** in advance of your child's absence from class in order to be eligible for a make-up class. Because of our strict student to teacher ratio, make-ups must be scheduled through our office, are not guaranteed and **cannot be rescheduled**. No refunds are given for classes missed.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/CANCELLED CLASSES:

All morning activities at KiDS body shop will automatically be cancelled when the Papillion/LaVista School District cancels their regular school-hour classes due to inclement weather conditions. For closings regarding activities during the afternoon/evening, a determination will be made and announcements will be posted by 12:00 p.m. that same day on our websites and a recording on our voicemail. A determination regarding Saturday classes will be made by 6:30 a.m. that same day.

If KiDS body shop holds activities but conditions still do not allow you to safely venture out, you will need to notify us of your child's absence in accordance with our regular make-up policy.

Make-Up Open To The Public coupons will be given to each gym student in lieu of make-up classes.

School holidays or other off days do not affect our schedule. Our School-Year Calendar is posted on the website.

ATTIRE:

No special uniform is required for gymnasts, but students must be able to stretch and move comfortably. Leotards or knit shorts and shirts are suggested. No socks, jeans/jean shorts, tights (with feet), gum, jewelry, belt buckles, or large barrettes/hair ribbons. No loose clothing that could get caught on equipment. Hair should be pulled back securely out of the gymnast's face.

Swimming students should wear a swim suit and bring a towel. Flotation devices, other than those provided by this facility for teaching purposes, are not allowed.

ARRIVALS-DEPARTURES:

Please be punctual. Parents are to stay with their child(ren) until class begins. If your child is self-sufficient in the restroom then you may leave the building once class is in session, however, we ask that you sign-out on the Sign-Out Sheet located on the lobby counter. During peak times the parking lot is crowded. We ask you to take into consideration that our students are young children. Please drive slowly and carefully. Do not take a chance on your student running to and from your car.

Please do not enter the pool area more than 10 minutes before your child(ren)'s class is scheduled to begin. Once they are changed please have them shower and use the restroom before class begins.

KiDS body shop Release of Liability

Gymnast (and if a minor, the undersigned as parent/guardian of Gymnast and for him or herself in attending events at KiDS body shop and using the facilities) voluntarily assumes all of the risks and dangers which are inherent in any gymnastic activity and the use of any gymnastic equipment. These risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, abrasions, contusions, concussions, lacerations, sprains, broken bones, serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, and death.

Gymnast (and if a minor, the undersigned) understands and acknowledges that neither KiDS body shop nor its employees, agents, volunteer assistants (collectively, "KiDS body shop") or other gymnasts are insurers against injury and that KiDS body shop offers its services to gymnasts at a cost which reflects the fact that it will not, and cannot, be monetarily responsible for personal injuries that may occur to a gymnast while on the premises or elsewhere. In consideration of this, and in consideration of the right to participate in gymnastics and related activities: (a) at KiDS body shop; (b) during competition at KiDS body shop and elsewhere; during travel to and/or from KiDS body shop; (d) during travel to and/or from competitions, and/or other related KiDS body shop activities, **the undersigned agrees to release, defend and hold KiDS body shop, all other gymnasts, visitors, other persons who may be present, and the owners and managers of the premises where KiDS body shop is located harmless from any claims and/or liability for damages arising directly or indirectly from any injury(ies) and damages sustained by Gymnast due, in whole or in part, to: (a) the negligence of KiDS body shop and/or other gymnasts or visitors; (b) the negligence of any owners and/or managers of the premises where KiDS body shop is located; any defective quality or performance either as to the manufacture, design, location and/or maintenance of any equipment or facilities used by KiDS body shop in its business, whether or not any such defective quality or performance is known or unknown to KiDS body shop, the Gymnast and/or the undersigned.**

To the extent that Gymnast is a minor, the undersigned as parent/guardian of Gymnast, gives his/her child permission to participate in any and all KiDS body shop programs.

Further, the undersigned, as the parent/guardian of Gymnast, represents and warrants that s/he carries adequate medical insurance on and for the Gymnast. The undersigned also gives his/her consent to KiDS body shop to provide, through a medical provider of its choosing, such medical attention, services, transportation, and/or emergency medical services as KiDS body shop, in its sole opinion, deems reasonably necessary. **This provision does not, and is not intended to, place any obligation upon KiDS body shop to provide any medical attention, services, transportation and/or emergency medical services to Gymnast or anyone else.**

By signing the Release of Liability, the undersigned acknowledges and represents that s/he is aware of the risks inherent to the use and operation of the KiDS body shop's facilities and equipment. The undersigned accepts full and complete responsibility for those risks and for any damages that may occur as a result of those risks even if injuries or damages occur in a manner that is or was not foreseeable at the time this Release of Liability is signed.

I also acknowledge and represent that no oral representation or statements or inducements have been made to me or for me that change, alter or modify anything contained in the Release of Liability. I have read this Release of Liability in its entirety and understand those legal rights which I am expressly and voluntarily waiving by signing below.
